



## **Official Utilities Protection Center, Inc. Business Notification Regarding the Large Project Implementation**

Duluth, GA – April 10, 2007 - During the Spring Georgia Utility Coordinating Council Meeting (GUCC) meeting last week in St. Simons, the decision was made to suspend the Large Project Notification Implementation.

The discussion between conference attendees, UPC conference presenters and Georgia Public Service commission (PSC) staff showed a need for more training among stakeholders, before implementing the Large Project Notification type. The PSC agreed to allow more time for training and information disbursement among UPC Member Utilities and the excavating community.

UPC Liaisons will be conducting training classes around the state in the upcoming weeks. UPC's goal is to offer approximately 50 meetings across Georgia that will inform and train those who will send and receive Large Project Notifications.
